Dates of Sessions: The first of 10 sessions will be Monday, June 16, 7-8:15 p.m. Sessions will be 75 minutes in length. The remaining 9 Monday evening sessions will be as follows: June 23, July 14 and 21, August 11 and 25, September 8 and 22, October 6 and 20 -- two sessions per month, but not always every other month (schedules!).
